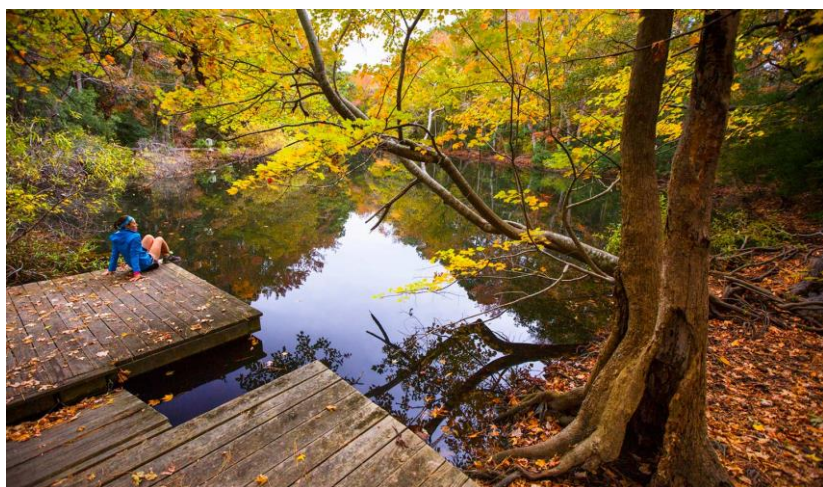


Nags Head Nature Conservancy

Overview: This trip address environmental and sustainability social justice issues. Nags Head Woods Preserve is owned and operated by The Nature Conservancy. The **mission** of The Nature Conservancy is to conserve the lands and waters on which all life depends. Their **vision** is a world where the diversity of life thrives, and people act to conserve nature for its own sake and its ability to fulfill our needs and enrich our lives.

Day-to-day: Participants will be assisting in park clean-up and up-keep including clearing trails, maintenance on park structures and clearing of invasive species. Students will be able to enjoy the park in the evenings after service. Service will be from approximately 9:00-5:00 each day.

The Nitty-Gritty Details: Participants will stay in cabins within the park. Participants should pack clothes for working outside, hiking and getting dirty. Meals are not provided by the housing or service sites but the group will be given a small grocery budget to purchase food and make meals throughout the week. Participants should expect to spend additional funds on some meals.
