

North Carolina Coastal: NEWPORT, NORTH CAROLINA

Overview: The North Carolina Coaster Federation is located in Newport, North Carolina near the Outer Banks and for more than 30 years, the North Carolina Coastal Federation has worked with people to safeguard the coastal rivers, creeks, sounds and beaches of North Carolina. The N.C. Coastal Federation has been able to preserve more than 10,000 acres of threatened coastal land since its establishment and has received multiple prestigious Pelican Awards that honor groups that exhibit exemplary performance in improving environmental quality on the N.C. coast.

Day-to-Day:

Participants will work daily from 9am-5pm planting native vegetation to restore marshes at the wetland restoration project sites. They will also help bag oyster shells that are used to build reefs, relay oyster bags, seed oyster reefs and monitor established reefs. There will also be an opportunity to partner and serve with Hammocks Beach State Park in additional environmental work.

The Nitty Gritty Details:

Participants will stay in cabins located on site. Participants should plan to bring their own sleeping bags/blankets and pillows. Meals are not provided by the housing or service site. Group members will have a small grocery budget to purchase some meal items. Participants should also plan to have additional funds for meals during the week.
