

Serving women-led families who face housing insecurity

Overview: For thirty-six years Ascension Place, Inc. has provided women in crisis or transition with a stable environment and the opportunity to explore options for their future. They have done this through three programs in Hennepin County: St. Anne's Place, an emergency shelter for women-led families experiencing extreme poverty and homelessness, Ascension Place, a transitional housing program where women stabilize, recover and rebuild their lives, and Next Step Housing, a permanent supportive housing program for women and women-led families working to maintain housing stability.

Day-to-day: The group will serve mainly at St Anne's Place and Ascension place. Projects might include redoing the overnight family room, redoing their workout room, organizing their attic, doing a painting project, and other maintenance and cleaning activities. The group will also have opportunities to help cook and serve dinner.

The Nitty-Gritty Details: Participants will stay in bunk rooms at the hostel where bedding is provided. Showers are available at the hostel. Breakfast will be provided at the hostel every day, and sack lunches will be provided during the weekdays. The group will have a small budget to spend on dinners and group activities.
