


Pairing with Sakhulwazi to empower local women to be economically independent

Overview: Ohio State will return to Cape Town to serve the local community and continue to build relationships with local non-profit organizations. This trip will focus on the themes of education, health awareness, women/gender, and international development as students will learn how these issues intersect with the history, culture, politics, and economy of South Africa. Additionally, students will have cultural lessons throughout the trip to learn about language, music, dance, and history and will visit several of the city's main attractions.
