

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY: BIRMINGHAM

Overview: Habitat for Humanity-Birmingham builds quality, affordable housing and revitalizes existing houses to encourage family stability and promote self-sufficiency, educational achievement, and responsible citizenship. Habitat Birmingham completes a minimum of 40-45 new houses each year; to date they have completed more than 350 homes. Habitat Birmingham has also sponsored close to 100 families internationally through their tithe program. Volunteers do not need to have any construction experience to make a meaningful impact on a family's life.

Day-to-Day: The group will volunteer from approximately 8:30-5:00 each day. Volunteer responsibilities could include yardwork, installing drywall, cabinets, siding, insulation, painting, framing, etc.

The Nitty Gritty Details: Volunteers will stay nearby in Habitat's volunteer housing. Participants should plan to bring their own bedding. Although most meals are included, participants should plan to have additional funds to pay for some food throughout the week. This is a 50 person trip.
