

COMMUNITY COLLABORATIONS INTERNATIONAL

Overview: Community Collaborations
International (CCI) takes a holistic
approach to community recovery. Historic
floods hit Baton Rouge in 2016 and the
community is still rebuilding. In addition
to homes directly impacted by the
weather, local community organizations,
such as food banks and after school
programs, struggle to meet the increased
needs of their clients and constituents.
Many of these organizations and their
staff members have suffered direct impact
from the flood. CCI volunteers will work
to help these organizations serve their
constituents and get back on their feet.

This location could be changed to Biloxi, Mississippi depending on the needs of the community.

Day-to-day: This is a 50 person trip and each day, the larger group will split into smaller groups to volunteer with a variety of organizations. Service includes a variety of tasks such as cleaning homes and city parks of flood debris, visiting the Boys and Girls club youth members and organizing non-profit organization supplies.

The Nitty-Gritty Details: Group members will sleep in large bunk rooms. Three meals per day will be provided by the site but participants may want to also purchase individual snacks for the week. The group will also spend one day in New Orleans to see the history and culture of the city.
